Definition: of service or assistance. Jesus is the consummate servant-leader. You see, to be a servant, to be helpful, does not mean to be a slave. Quite the contrary, Jesus served – even to the cross. It was written of Him in the book of the Prophet Isaiah –

“The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console

those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

Isaiah 61:1-3

Jesus did these things and more. Each is an act of service. Why do effective leaders serve? Because their service enables those they serve to go on and do more, to be more.
